

THREADS WEST, AN AMERICAN SAGA

The epic saga of *Threads West, An American Saga* begins in 1854 with the first of five, richly textured, complex generations of unforgettable, multicultural characters. The separate lives of these driven men and inspired women from Europe and America are drawn to a common destiny that beckons seductively from the wild and remote flanks of the American West. Swept into the dangerous currents of the far-distant frontier by the mysterious rivers of fate, the power of the land and the American spirit, their paths will intersect with the trails of others; an Oglala Sioux family, an elderly black couple setting their life sails for the winds of freedom, devout Mormons on the Exodus, a black-hearted renegade and his tender, young capture, Spanish blood exiled from the south and a shrewd Ute Chief and his wives. Fierce loyalties will emerge, deep loves flame, and bitter enmities explode, setting in motion conflicts and bonds affecting each of their lineages over one hundred and seventy years of United States history.

Another horse breaks in: "Well in the last 27 races, I've won 19!"


"Oh, that's good, but in the last 36 races, I've won 28!" says another.


