

BEFORE RETURNING HOME WITH YOUR ANIMALS

Check your hauler has experience, a safe trailer & a proper vehicle.

Check your fencing & structures for damage.

Make sure that you have electricity and water.

Check your animal's feed and water supplies for contamination from slurry, soot, mud etc. The slurry is **non toxic**, but should be shaken off feed and removed from water tanks.

Keep an eye on your animal's health. Stress & smoke inhalation, for example, can cause on-going problems.

If your animals are not current with their immunizations & because of their recent exposure to many other animals, now would be a good time to bring them up-to-date.

Colorado Law requires all horse & cattle owners to have an inspection certificate. If you don't have the proper inspection papers or travel papers for proof of ownership, it is strongly recommended that you contact the Colorado Brand Board of Stock Inspection at 303-294-0895.
